Minutes of the October meeting

Members of Cascade Pacific Plymouth club met on Tuesday, October 24, 2023, at the Clackamas Community Club, 15711 SE 90th Ave., Clackamas, OR.

Nineteen members were in attendance. Robin Will took the minutes.

Vice-President Jake Higginbotham called the meeting to order at 6:30PM and led the salute to the flag.

First item of business: Jake solicited sign-ups for CPPC secretary(ies). The role has gone unfilled for several years, which is not optimal.

Jake thanked Dave and Mindy Benfield for bringing refreshments.

New members: Jake announced that he had met Jim and Trina King at the Canby Swap Meet, and they had become club members. They live in Lake-side, OR (near Coos Bay) so we probably won't be seeing much of them. They recently acquired a 1937 Plymouth coupe, in good barn-find condition, which is their reason for joining the club.

In that connection, Jake mentioned that the Kings bought their car from a man in Anacortes who is liquidating a car collection. Several cars are currently advertised on the Northern Washington craigslist.

Jake read Treasurer Dolores Call's summary of CPPC's financial condition. The club is in good shape; any board member can provide details.
